HKIC offers training programmes in full-time and part-time modes. Full-time (Training) Short Programme is designed for the adults from other industries who wish to equip with a specific set of operational and craft skills after completing a well-structured short programme and join the construction industry.

To nurture an accomplished construction workforce with sound professional skills, theoretical knowledge, safety awareness, innovative ideas, passion and pride for the construction industry of Hong Kong.

Mission

- To provide training in construction and management skills based on whole person education and construction site practices;
- To promote a culture of work safety and sustainability for the construction industry;
- To foster a culture of career dedication and pursuit of excellence for the construction industry; and
- To build up a healthy and caring image of the construction industry.



Mode of Training

Focus on training of techniques and skills to meet the needs of the trades in the industry.

Training Allowance

Free tuition. Students will receive an allowance of maximum HK\$12,910 per month according to their attendance and employment status. (The allowance includes basic allowance of maximum HK\$10,000 per month and the retention allowance. The retention allowance will be provided after students have successfully completed the programme, passed the Intermediate Trade Test and confirmed staying in the construction industry 3 months after graduation. This arrangement applies to all Enhanced Construction Manpower Training programmes starting on or after 1 May 2023)

Career Progression and Employment

Graduates will be provided with career support and employment counselling in order to help them joining the industry.

Award of Certificate

Attained 95% attendance and passed the Intermediate Trade Test.

Upon completion of training and passing the intermediate trade test, graduates can register as "Registered Semi-Skilled Worker" under the current Workers Registration System which further improves employment opportunities.

NOTES TO APPLICANTS

- Aged 18 or above; and
- Able to communicate in English; and
- oplicants should be Hong Kong legal residents and are permitted to stay and work in Hong Kong;

Applicant will generally receive a reply within 7 working days. HKIC will arrange interviews with eligible candidates.

Admission Criteria

- HKIC will conduct assessment according to the information provided in the application form by the applicant. Listed below are the factors and criteria for consideration in the assessment process:

 a. Basic and priority admission conditions;
- b. Comparison among applicants for the same programme;
- c. Performance during the interview or the test result for certain programmes;
- d. Desire for joining the construction industry.
- Priority will be given to applicants with recommendation and commitment to offer employment opportunities after completion of the programme from employers in the construction or related industries.
 If the applicants may be required to receive a physical test / colour blind test before admission to assess whether they have the
- appropriate abilities to receive training, they must accept and pass the test.
- In general, HKIC will not accept application for any full-time programme from student of full-time programmes within one year after graduation. During assessment of application for re-admission, "employment intention" and "performance during training" are important considerations.
- HKIC may accept or reject any application in its absolute sole discretion and is not obliged to provide any reason(s) for accepting or rejecting any application.

Remarks

- Applicants should have appropriate abilities to distinguish colours, suitable conditions, and the ability to lift heavy loads manually. Those who are under long-term medication may require recommendation from a medical practitioner.

 (Should a student fail to catch up the curriculum, HKIC may request the student to withdraw from training.)
